



WHAT GOES ON AT AN INTRODUCTORY IOWATER WORKSHOP?

A variety of session settings, indoors and outdoors (wading shoes, rubber boots or waders are needed), will contain topics such as starting a monitoring plan, the "why-to" and "how-to" of water monitoring, what to do with the data, networking with others in your area concerned with water quality, and some muddy fun!

All Introductory workshops are based on eight hours of training. Hours may vary depending on location (see schedule on reverse side). Workshop registration fee is \$20.00 dollars per person*. This fee covers all program fees, meals, and testing equipment. Check should be payable to Iowa DNR and sent to the local workshop contact.

Confirmation letters with directions to training sites and a "what to bring" list will be mailed out after your registration is received. Maximum workshop attendance is thirty-five participants. Registration deadline is one week before the workshop, so get yours in early!!

*Group registration fee is \$30.00 for up to three people; ten dollars for each additional person (please send everyone's name and contact information with the registration form). Each group receives only one set of equipment to share. Note if you are a state employee you must register as an individual if you are attending for work.
